

## Terms and Conditions

1. The LOGO and Rap-Song competition will run from 18 November 2018 to 16 February 2019. Entries received after the closing date will not be considered, unless approved by the competition organisers. Winners will be notified soon after, once the judging panel has decided the best entries.
2. Entry requirements: Participants must be 14 years and older, (Parents/Adults are also encouraged to apply).
3. By entering this Competition, all Participants agree to be bound by these terms and conditions, and the organiser's decision regarding any issue with the Competition will be final and binding, and no correspondence will be entered into.
4. A completed application form must be attached to the one-page Rap-Song and or LOGO before handing in.
5. Only one entry is allowed, meaning participants either submit a LOGO or Rap-song.
6. The application forms can be collected from either your youth hostel or youth club and or various outlets and stores that will be mentioned on [www.dhconsulting.me.uk](http://www.dhconsulting.me.uk) in the coming weeks.
7. The organisers are not responsible for any entry that is not delivered, received or are delayed or damaged due to technical reasons, including telecommunication failure on the part of the Participant's service provider, or otherwise. Proof of sending is not proof of receipt.
8. Incomplete or incorrect entries will not be eligible to be entered into the final judging.
9. All tie-break questions must be answered.

### PRIZES:

10. There will be various awards for the winner, runner-up and third place entries. The overall winners will go into a national final where a neutral panel will judge their work. The overall winner will not only win a prize but also have their work displayed on the up and coming book Degsy Hay, The Hay Patrollers, due out early 2019.
11. The Promoters reserve the right to substitute the prizes for an alternative award of equal or higher value should the rewards promoted not be available due to unforeseen circumstances.
12. The Promoters will not be liable for any loss suffered as a result of incomplete or incorrect information provided.
13. The Promoters reserve the right to withhold prizes in the event that they reasonably believe, in their sole discretion, that the winner is not eligible to win, has contravened any of these terms and conditions, has acted in a manner that is not in the spirit of the Competition, their

conduct can be reasonably interpreted as scamming or circumventing the rules of the Competition, acted fraudulently with regards to the Competition, if it would be unlawful to award the prize or if the winner fails to accept the award after 2 (two) attempts for any reason whatsoever. In this instance, the winner will be disqualified and forfeit the prize. The Promoters' decision shall be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

The organisers reserve the right to shorten, extend, suspend the period of the Competition or terminate the Competition whenever it should so choose for technical, commercial, or operational reasons, or for reasons beyond its control or generally for any reason whatsoever within their sole discretion. The Competition, its prizes, and terms and conditions may be amended by the Promoters, at any time during the Competition, and will be applied and interpreted within their sole discretion. In such an event, all Participants waive any rights that they may have/purport to have regarding this Competition and acknowledge that they will have no recourse against the Promoters whatsoever.
15. All entries, artwork and other material will be the sole property of the organisers.
16. The organisers are not liable for any technical failures affecting participation in the competition, and they assume no liability in this regard.
17. To the fullest extent permitted by law, by participating, the Participant indemnifies, releases and agrees to hold harmless the organisers, their associated, holding and subsidiary companies, and its directors, officers, agents, representatives, shareholders, employees, successors and assigns from any and all claims or liability arising from participating in the Competition, any Competition-related activity and/or acceptance, receipt, possession or use/misuse of any prize.
